

ASCIS UNIFORM POLICY

General Uniform Information

ASCIS guides students to become mature and responsible individuals with socially acceptable behaviour. Since the ASCIS uniform is well-recognized in our community, students are expected to wear the uniform with pride and respect for our school as an institution as well as for our school community (i.e., staff, colleagues, classmates, themselves and ASCIS' families). The uniform must be clean and neat; it may never be wrinkled or disheveled.

The **ASCIS Dress Code** expects students to make respectful and distinguished decisions in appearance. ASCIS reserves the right to determine what is acceptable attire at ASCIS.

Out-of-Uniform Days

On designated days, which will be announced in advance, students will be allowed to dress as they wish providing they make modest and appropriate choices.

Students must wear proper footwear during classes (i.e., **no flip flops, clogs, etc. at any time during the school day**).

The following is a partial list of unacceptable attire: tights, bathing attire, halter tops, off the shoulder tops, T-shirts or sweatshirts with offensive or inappropriate messages, revealing clothing, clothing that exposes parts of undergarments and midriff area, etc. Hats are not allowed except on designated 'hat days'. If a hooded sweatshirt is worn, the hood must remain down.

If an ASCIS Staff deems a student's attire to be unacceptable, the matter will be discussed with the Head of School who will contact and then expect the student (and whenever necessary, the parent(s)) to cooperate by promptly addressing and rectifying the problem in order to adhere to the ASCIS policies and decision. **Since this student shall be allowed to resume classes only after rectifying the specified impropriety, parents may need to bring-in the proper attire or return their children home to be online for the rest of the day.**

Upper School Uniform (Regular Uniform Days)

N.B.: No running shoes (black or otherwise) or boots of any kind are permitted in the classroom during regular uniform days. Regular Uniform days will be Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and as announced.

MALE STUDENTS*

- McCarthy's charcoal grey men's pants
- White long- or short- sleeved Oxford button-down collared shirt with school crest
- Navy V-necked sweater **or** cardigan with school crest. These are to be worn with Oxford shirt and Mackenzie Tartan tie, **or**,
- Navy Hopsack blazer with school crest
- Mackenzie Tartan tie
- Black/Navy Dress socks
- Black leather dress shoes
- Black belt

FEMALE STUDENTS*

- McCarthy charcoal grey lady's pant with Navy/black dress socks **or**
- Mackenzie Tartan kilt (no shorter than 1" above the top of the kneecap) and **must be worn with navy/black tights or nylons**
- White long- or short- sleeved Oxford button-down collared shirt with school crest
- Navy V-necked sweater **or** cardigan with school crest. These are to be worn with Oxford shirt and Mackenzie Tartan tie, **or**,
- Navy Hopsack blazer with school crest
- Mackenzie Tartan tie
- Black leather dress shoes (no more than 2" heel)
- Black belt

*N.B: ALL STUDENTS

The Oxford shirt and Mackenzie Tartan tie are mandatory for classroom dress for all Upper School students.

- Undershirts and T-shirts worn under Oxford dress shirt must be plain white.
- Only black dress shoes are permitted in the classroom. Black dress shoes are to be made of a leather type material, with a closed toe and closed heel, and solid black in colour (secondary colours in the stitching, laces and overlapping materials are not acceptable).
- **No running shoes (black or otherwise) or boots of any kind are permitted in the classroom on regular uniform days.**

ASCIS UNIFORM POLICY

Upper School Uniform (Formal Dress Uniform)

N.B.: No running shoes (black or otherwise) or boots of any kind are permitted in the classroom during formal dress uniform days.

Formal Dress Uniform must be worn all day every Wednesday and as announced.

Sweaters may be worn in complement with the blazer, but may not be worn in lieu of the blazer on dress uniform days.

MALE STUDENTS

- McCarthy's charcoal grey men's pants
- White long- or short- sleeved Oxford button-down collared shirt with school crest
- Mackenzie Tartan tie
- Navy Hopsack blazer with school crest
- Black/Navy dress socks
- Black leather dress shoes
- Black belt

FEMALE STUDENTS

- McCarthy charcoal grey lady's pant with Navy/black Dress socks or
- Mackenzie Tartan kilt (no shorter than 1" above the top of the kneecap) must be worn with navy/black tights or nylons
- White long- or short- sleeved Oxford button-down collared shirt with school crest
- Mackenzie Tartan tie
- Navy Hopsack blazer with school crest
- Black leather dress shoes

Upper School Uniform (Spirit Wear Days)

ALL STUDENTS

Spirit Wear days will be on Fridays or announced during special event days.

N.B.: No running shoes (black or otherwise) or boots of any kind are permitted in the classroom unless wearing ASCIS track suits.

- All regular and Formal dress uniform items are permitted
- Red golf shirt with the school crest (worn on Fridays only)
- School "hoodies" and other school spirit wear (worn on Fridays only)
- Sports, class and trip ASCIS branded shirts or sweaters (worn on Fridays only)
- School provided and ASCIS branded tracksuits are permitted and can be worn with respectable closed toe running shoes (worn on Fridays only)
- If students wear ASCIS dress pants during spirit wear days, dress shoes are required.
- **Sandals are never permitted**
